AUTHOR GUIDELINE

The following are general provisions for script writing. Authors are expected to carefully observe and follow the writing template available on the Jurnal Pangan dan Agroindustri website.

Submission Manuscript Guidelines

Jurnal Pangan dan Agroindustri will only process manuscripts that are relevant to the scope or topic. Manuscript processing will only be done through the online mechanism (Open Journal System/OJS), and submissions via email or postal mail will not be processed. Submitted manuscripts will undergo an editorial review process and peer review. The editor reserves the right to reject manuscripts that are not within the scope or do not meet the considerations of the peer reviewers.

Manuscript Format

Manuscripts submitted to the Jurnal Pangan dan Agroindustri must be in proper and correct Indonesian language. The manuscript should be in Word format, A4 size, single-spaced, and a maximum of 12 pages.

Title

The title should reflect and encompass the main content of the research but not be too long (maximum of 15 words), and should be presented in both Indonesian and English.

Author Names, Affiliations, and Corresponding Email

Author names must be written in full along with their affiliations/institutions. Multiple authors can combine their affiliations/institutions if they are from the same institution. Each manuscript must provide a valid and active corresponding email for communication between the authors and the Journal.

Abstract

The abstract should be presented in both Indonesian and English, with a maximum of 150 words. The abstract should cover three main aspects: research objectives, research methods, and research findings. The abstract must include relevant keywords (3-5 words) that reflect the research substance.

Introduction

The introduction section contains background information that provides an explanation related to the problem, and the literature used should be relevant. The research objectives are stated in the introduction.

Research Method

The research method should be clear and detailed, but not overly lengthy, explaining the procedures used in the research.

Results and Discussion

The results and discussion section presents the discussion of the research findings.

Conclusion

The conclusion section should be concise, explaining the achievement of the research objectives. The conclusion clarifies the research results and answers the research objectives. The conclusion should not contain numerical experimental results and should not be a repetition of the abstract. Suggestions for this research or suggestions for further research can also be provided.

Acknowledgments

Acknowledgments can be addressed to funders or parties who have contributed/assisted in the implementation of the research (optional).

References

Ensure that the manuscript uses valid references and provide links/addresses for references if possible. Journal references are expected to constitute at least 80% of the total references, and all references should be relatively recent. Use the APA 7th edition citation style.
